



FIRST ANNUAL RECOGNITION LUNCHEON NOMINATION FORM

For its first Recognition Luncheon, the New York State Cultural Heritage Tourism Network would like to honor projects that celebrated New York State's Suffrage Centennial. Projects can be nominated in one of five categories:

- Publication (a book or exhibit catalog)
- Educational and Public Program
- Exhibition
- Multimedia (DVD, website, or other product)
- Special Project (All aspects of a larger project will be reviewed. For example, an exhibition with related educational and public programs and a publication.)

Projects must have been completed in 2017 by a cultural heritage site for the New York State Suffrage Centennial. Nominees do not have to be members of the New York Cultural Heritage Tourism Network. Self-nominations are encouraged. For projects with cross-institutional partnerships, one organization must be designated the lead organization who will nominate the project. Entries will be judged in two budget levels - operating under \$250,000 and operating \$250,000 and over.

Honorees will be acknowledged on **Thursday, November 8**,
as part of our *First Annual Recognition Luncheon at the Oneida Community Mansion*.

 - The project's main objectives and how they were achieved.
 - How the project benefited the public.
 - How the project is an outstanding example in its category.
 - How the project was relevant to the 2017 New York State Suffrage Centennial.
- Project documentation must be submitted as attached pdfs and may include photographs, audio, video, press releases, an excerpt from a publication, newspaper articles, reviews, URLs, or other promotional materials. Up to 7 pieces of documentation can be submitted.
